


We welcome you to the house of our true and living God for worship. If you are visiting us today, please come again. May the Lord bless our worship!


# **Prayer before Worship**


Dear friends, let us approach God with a true heart and confess our sins, asking him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to forgive us.

#### Prayer of the Day






