The second graders will have their spelling test next Wednesday. Their spelling words are: was, close, class, mess, quiz, does, doesn't, goes, busy, buzz, easy, and because.

In math, they will be learning about horizontal, vertical, oblique lines, and dividing a whole into halves, fourths, and eighths, sums of 10, weighing objects, adding 10 to a multiple of 10, pairs, tens and ones, and identifying halves, fourths, eighths of a whole.

## Fourth Graders

The fourth graders spelling words will be sent home today. Their spelling test will be next Wednesday. Their words are on unit 8.

In math they will be learning about subtraction word problems, drawing pictures of fractions, multiplication as repeated addition, multiplication table, multiplication facts 1,2,5, and 0, and subtracting 3 digit numbers with regrouping.

## Third Grade

In math the third graders will be learning about adding 9, writing fraction number sentences that equal 1, dozen, half dozen, reading and writing numbers to 1000 using digits, writing money amounts using dollar and cents signs, reading and shading a thermometer to 2 degrees, collecting data and tallying, adding 3 and 4.

The third graders spelling test will be next Wednesday. Their words are on unit 8.

## First Grade

The first graders will be learning about doubles to 18, pattern to solve problems, covering a design using pattern blocks, ordering numbers to 20, adding 1 to a number, writing numbers for some, some went away, counting backward from 10 to 1, morning, afternoon, evening, and night, and adding 1 to a number.
